MUNICH SIGHTSEEING

This morning, visit Frauenkirche, Munich's cathedral, built in 1488 in late Gothic style. The Cathedral is an important symbol of the city and a central landmark. Then, continue on to visit the magnificent Residenz Palace, Germany's largest city palace, which features diverse architectural styles that reflect its long history of expansion and redesign. Residenz Palace is also one of Europe's most important palace museums and is home to a vast collection of art and historical artifacts from various periods. After your visit, embark on a guided tour of Munich, Capital of Bavaria. Along the way, journey into the city's medieval Old Town, a popular spot for locals with bustling shops and charming cafes, before visiting Marienplatz, the central square of Munich. Stop to see the world-famous Glockenspiel, a mechanical clock which was first installed in 1908 and performs two 16th century historical reenactments daily. Following, visit Viktualienmarkt, the city's central outdoor food market, offering a wide variety of fresh produce, local delicacies and fresh flowers. Return to your hotel, where you might like to freshen up before tonight's festivities.

This evening, head to Hofbrauhaus Restaurant to enjoy dinner with your fellow travelers.

OKTOBERFEST

Spend the day at leisure to experience Munich's Oktoberfest, the world's largest beer and folk festival, which celebrates Bavarian culture. Travel to Munich's Theresienwiese fairgrounds to take part in unique cultural traditions, sample classic Bavarian food and enjoy the festive atmosphere. Later in the day, head to the Augustiner Tent to have dinner with your group before returning to your hotel for an evening at leisure.

EAGLE'S NEST

Leaving Munich, journey into Berchtesgaden, an intriguing Bavarian destination located along the western end of the "Alpine Road". Upon arrival, set off on an orientation tour of the area, which offers stunning alpine scenery. Next, ascent to the Kehlsteinhaus or "Eagle's Nest", located near the peak of an alpine mountain. Visit this impressive structure that was built for the Nazi leader, Adolf Hitler. While he only visited it fourteen times, his friends and wife, Eva Braun, visited the residency on more frequent basis. The surrounding mountains offer spectacular views, and no expense was spared inside including the brass elevator. Continue your drive into Salzburg, check into your hotel and enjoy some time at leisure to freshen up before dining in the hotel restaurant with your group.

SALZBURG SIGHTSEEING

Today, visit the impressive Hohensalzburg Fortress, one of the largest and best-preserved medieval castles in Europe. Hohensalzburg Castle is filled with many secrets and is surrounded by dominating Medieval walls. Next, journey to visit Mozart's birthplace, a museum dedicated to the composer's life and early works. Here, you will have the opportunity to view Mozart's original instruments, personal items and letters. Following, visit the nearby Mozart Residence, a larger home where the family lived from 1773 to 1787. Discover more about Mozart's life before viewing his piano and violin as well as manuscripts and portraits. Return to your hotel in time to dine with your fellow travelers in the hotel restaurant.

Tue, Sep-22

THE SALTMINE BAD

This morning, journey to visit The Saltmine Bad Dürrenberg (Hallein Salt Mine) to discover the ancient history of salt mining, which began here over 2,500 years ago. Stroll through the museum, which showcases the history of The Celtics, who were the first to mine the salt. You might also have the opportunity to ride a miner's train, slide down two long wooden slides or cross the underground lake on a raft. Return to Salzburg and stop to visit the stunning Mirabell Gardens, known for its Baroque design and vibrant flowerbeds. The site also doubled as the world-famous filming location for the movie *The Sound of Music*, specifically for the "Do-Re-Mi" song scene. Following, set off to view sites that doubled as filming locations for the classic movie, *The Sound of Music*. Along the way, you might view Leopoldskron Palace, used for scenes at the Von Trapp family home, or Schloss Frohnburg, which served as the exterior of the Von Trapp villa. Head back to your hotel for some free time to freshen up before gathering with your group in the hotel restaurant for dinner.

Wed, Sep-23

SALZBURG TO FUSSEN

Departing Salzburg, drive into Wattens and embark on a panoramic tour to see the highlights of the town, known as the Headquarters of the Swarovski Crystal Company, which was established here in 1895. Stop to visit Swarovski Crystal Worlds, a unique sensory experience designed by different artists, incorporating crystal in various ways. The entrance is famously known for its iconic giant head-shaped structural design that spills water from its mouth into a reflective pool below. After, journey into Innsbruck and set off on a sightseeing tour of the city, known as the "Capital of the Alps". Your guide will share some of the city's history as you journey through the Old Town to see its medieval and baroque architecture. Along the way, view The Golden Roof (Goldenes Dachl), a historical landmark and balcony, built in 1500 by Emperor Maximilian to watch events in the square below. Its prominent gilded copper roof creates a shimmering gold appearance and is one of Austria's most iconic sights. Next, view Hofkirche, the mausoleum of Emperor Maximilian I, which is surrounded by 28 larger-than-life bronze statues. Continue on to view one of Austria's most significant cultural landmarks, the 15th century Innsbruck Hofburg, a former imperial residence of the powerful Habsburg dynasty. Innsbruck Hofburg is a fine example of late-Baroque architecture and is home to a significant collection of art and historical artifacts from the Habsburg era. Then, pass by Helblinghaus, one of the most visually striking buildings in the city's Old Town, which features an elaborate, "icing-like" Rococo facade. Transfer to your hotel in Fussen, check in and settle into your room. This evening, dine in the hotel restaurant with your group.

DACHAU CONCENTRATION CAMP

After breakfast, travel into the town of Dachau, known as the location of the first Nazi concentration camp, and set off on a panoramic tour to see the principal sites of the area. Stop to visit The Dachau Concentration Camp Memorial Site, which was established in 1965 by former prisoners, and is known for preserving this history and honouring the victims who died there. The former Concentration Camp Dachau was first to opened in 1933 and was the longest-operating Nazi concentration camp. Head back to your hotel in Munich and spend the balance of the day at leisure. In the evening, you might like to dine in one of the many traditional or modern dinner venues located within the city.

NEUSCHWANSTEIN CASTLE

After breakfast, journey to visit the magnificent 19th century Hohenschwangau Castle, which was the childhood home of King Ludwig II of Bavaria. The castle is a fine example of Romantic architecture and is surrounded by beautiful natural landscapes, including several lakes and the Alps. King Ludwig II found influence in Hohenschwangau and later built his own famous castle, Neuschwanstein. Continue on to visit Neuschwanstein Castle, which was built by King Ludwig II of Bavaria in 1886 and is renowned for its fairytale-like architecture. The castle is said to be the inspiration for Disney's Sleeping Beauty Castle. Following, travel into Ettal to visit the glamorous Linderhof Palace, built in 1886 by King Ludwig II. The Palace was the smallest of three built by King Ludwig but was the only one he lived to see completed. Head back to your hotel in Fussen, where you may like to freshen up before dining in the hotel restaurant with your fellow travelers.

ANDECHS MONASTERY BREWERY

Today, journey to visit the Monastery of Andechs, a well-known monastic brewery, which produces high-quality beers and features a Baroque church. Next, head to Ayinger, a traditional Bavarian restaurant serving regional cuisines alongside its beer, brewed by the family-run brewery. Here, have lunch with your fellow travelers. Then, continue your drive into Munich, check into your hotel and enjoy some free time to freshen up before a festive evening with your group.

Tonight, travel to Munich's Oktoberfest, where you will have a splendid dinner with your fellow travelers.
